ACCESS

The club operates a keyfob access system which gives access to the main gate and the clubhouse. If you need a keyfob, please contact our Membership Secretary, Kate Drew, (membership@glanaber.com). There is a £20 deposit, refundable on return. If the Clubhouse is locked, there is a keysafe – access details are on the outside noticeboard.

COURT BOOKING

We have a court booking system to help manage the use of the courts. Members are able to book courts either by using the link from our Glan Aber website (www.glanaber.com), the Clubspark website (www.clubspark.lta.org.uk), or by downloading the ClubSpark booking app for your phone. Members can book up to seven days in advance and can book up to 5 sessions (max 2 hours each) per week. If you have any issues, please ask.

There are currently some blocks that cannot be booked: these are reserved for junior/ adult group coaching sessions, League matches and organised Club social tennis sessions.

SOCIAL TENNIS SESSIONS

The following organised group sessions run at the club: **Adult Club Nights** – Tuesdays and Thursdays from 18:00 **Weekend Adult Session** – Saturdays 13.00-15.00 **Junior Club Afternoon** – Saturdays 15.00-17.00 (seasonal – booked through ACTA app)

TENNIS COURTS

The four floodlit courts have been re-surfaced with <u>Tiger Turf Advantage Pro</u>. There are no specific maintenance tasks to be completed after play but please remember to remove all your possessions and adhere to the following guidelines when using the courts:



We undertake regular court maintenance – at these times the courts may be closed.

FLOODLIGHTS

We are delighted with our new LED floodlights which operate by on/ off switches. Lights can be can be paid for by bank transfer and cost £1.50 for half an hour. To aid our Treasurer please pay in £5 or £10 amounts. Club night sessions are £2 each and can be paid in advance by bank transfer (again in £10 amounts) or in cash on the evening (if no committee member is present please put money in the red box in the club house). We have a curfew of 10.00pm and the lights will switch off automatically at that time.

TENNIS BALLS – NEW & OLD

Whilst there are usually tennis balls in the Club house, it's as well to bring balls with you just in case. Sometimes balls get wet and are left in tins which makes them unfit for play. Tins of 4 tennis balls can be purchased from Sue Britton by prior arrangement... usually Dunlop Fort All Court. We do recycle old balls for which the Club receives payment.

CLUBHOUSE

It's up to us, the members, to keep the Club clean and tidy, so please do your best to keep it as you find it.

Tea and coffee are available in the kitchen but you'll need to bring milk. Do help yourself but please remember to wash up and put away cups after use.

LOST PROPERTY

There is a box in the Clubhouse for lost property. After 12 weeks, items are disposed of appropriately.

SAFEGUARDING

The safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults is of paramount importance at our Club. We recommend that children under the age of 12 years are accompanied at the Club by a responsible adult.

CLUB SOCIALS AND EVENTS

BRITISH TENNIS MEMBERSHIP

Our members are encouraged to become British Tennis Members at no cost (www.lta.org.uk/member). Apart from accessing LTA offers, you have the option to join the ballot for Wimbledon tickets. Tickets are now issued directly by Wimbledon and BTM members must opt into the ballot each year – if you have chosen not to receive email communications, you won't be notified when the opt in window opens. If you are successful in the ballot, you will be given instructions on how to choose and accept tickets..... you also have the option to decline.

GUESTS

Members are allowed to bring local guests to play a maximum of 4 times before the guest is required to join. Those living more than 25 miles from the Club are unrestricted. The visitor's fee is £3.00 and can be left in the black box in the Clubhouse.
