IMPORTANT INFORMATION & CONTACT DETAILS

SAFEGUARDING

The safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults is of paramount importance at our Club. The Club's Welfare Officers are Andrea Hopkinson (andreajanehop@gmail.com / 07792 474504) and Donald Boyd (d.boyd3@sky.com / 07359 108994) who can be contacted in the first instance if you have any concerns. The club's Safeguarding Policy and further useful details can be viewed on the safeguarding noticeboard in the clubhouse and on the Club website under the 'Important Information'.

We recommend that children up to Year 6 are accompanied at the Club by a responsible adult unless on a supervised session.

ACCESS

The club operates a keyfob access system which gives access to the main gate and the clubhouse. If you need a keyfob, please contact our Membership Secretary, Kate Drew, (membership@glanaber.com). There is a £20 deposit, refundable on return. This can be paid by BACS to Glan Aber Tennis Club account 17014760, sort code 77-48-10.

If the Clubhouse is locked, there is a keysafe – access details are on the outside noticeboard.

CCTV

We have security cameras installed due to various incursions from non-members and for the safety of everyone. We do monitor the courts and clubhouse at all times.

COURT BOOKING

We have a court booking system to help manage the use of the courts. Members are able to book courts either by using the link from our Glan Aber website (www.glanaber.com), the Clubspark website (www.clubspark.lta.org.uk), or by downloading the ClubSpark booking app for your phone. Members can book up to seven days in advance and can book up to 5 sessions (max 2 hours each) per week. If you have any issues, please ask. We request that members always book a court so that we can monitor court usage.

There are currently some blocks that cannot be booked: these are reserved for junior/ adult group coaching sessions, League matches and organised Club social tennis sessions.

SOCIAL TENNIS SESSIONS

The following organised group sessions run at the club:

Adult Club Nights – Tuesdays and Thursdays from 18:00

Pay & Play Coaching – Saturdays 11.00-12.00 - coaching included if 4 players sign up. No charge for members. Non-members welcome but pay £3 (no coach) or £5 (with coaching).

Weekend Adult Session – Saturdays 13.00-15.00

COACHING

All Court Tennis Academy (ACTA) offers a full programme of junior and adult group and individual lessons. For all coaching enquiries, please contact either of our Head Coaches, Phil Hough (07540 082727) or Lydia Mountford-Metcalf (07889 979801). We are fortunate to have junior coaching assistants and leaders on the team.

Phil and Lydia are delighted that ACTA will continue to provide tennis at the Kings School in addition to the sessions at Glan Aber and Tarporley tennis clubs.

TENNIS COURTS

The four floodlit courts were re-surfaced with [Tiger Turf Advantage Pro](#). There are no specific maintenance tasks to be completed after play but please remember to remove all your possessions. We undertake regular court maintenance – at these times the courts may be closed.

FLOODLIGHTS

We are delighted to update that there will be no additional charge for floodlights during the season 2026-27. This is a trial period and will be reviewed.

CLUBHOUSE

It's up to us, the members, to keep the Club clean and tidy, so please do your best to keep it as you find it. We have an excellent cleaner who attends weekly.

Tea and coffee are available in the kitchen but you'll need to bring milk. Do help yourself but please remember to wash up and put away cups after use.

CLUB SOCIALS AND EVENTS

We will be running an Open Day on Saturday 9 May to celebrate 25 years of Glan Aber being in the park. This also coincides with the 80th Anniversary Celebration Day of the park and 50th anniversary of the opening of the golf course, so there will be lots of activities going on. Other tournaments and Club competitions will run during the year. Details can be found on the Club website and will be put on the noticeboards at the Club.

LOST PROPERTY

There is a box in the Clubhouse for lost property. After 12 weeks, items are disposed of appropriately.

TENNIS BALLS – NEW & OLD

Whilst there are usually tennis balls in the Club house, it's as well to bring balls with you just in case. Sometimes balls get wet and are left in tins which makes them unfit for play. Tins of 4 tennis balls can be purchased from Sue Britton by prior arrangement... usually Dunlop Fort All Court. We do recycle old balls for which the Club receives payment.

BRITISH TENNIS MEMBERSHIP

Our members are encouraged to become British Tennis Members at no cost (www.lta.org.uk/member). Apart from accessing LTA offers, you have the option to join the ballot for Wimbledon tickets. Tickets are now issued directly by Wimbledon and BTM members must opt into the ballot each year – if you have chosen not to receive email communications, you won't be notified when the opt in window opens. If you are successful in the ballot, you will be given instructions on how to choose and accept tickets..... you also have the option to decline.

GUESTS

Members are allowed to bring local guests to play a maximum of 4 times before the guest is required to join. Those living more than 25 miles from the Club are unrestricted. The visitor's fee is £3.00 and can be left in the black box in the Clubhouse.

CODE OF CONDUCT

TO BE OBSERVED BY MEMBERS AND USERS OF GLAN ABER FACILITIES

All persons playing tennis at Glan Aber Tennis Club are asked to show consideration to other players by adhering to the following

1. DRESS / FOOTWEAR

- Players must be appropriately dressed
- Tennis shoes/ trainers must be worn on court
- Football boots or shoes with any sort of spikes are not permitted
- Normal footwear with heels is not permitted

2. BEHAVIOUR

Players to refrain from unacceptable behaviour, i.e.

- Throwing of rackets or other items
- Use of offensive language
- Spitting
- Chewing gum is prohibited on court
- Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is prohibited
- Games other than tennis are forbidden
- No bicycles are permitted on court

3. USE OF COURTS

- Juniors may play at all times except for adult club sessions
- The committee recommends that juniors (up to Year 6) are accompanied by a responsible adult unless attending a supervised session
- League matches to be played at Glan Aber Tennis Club will have priority
- Courts should be booked through the Clubspark booking system

4. DOGS

- Prohibited on court or in clubhouse
- Must be kept on a leash whilst on premises (CWaC directive)
